**U.S.–Canadian Equivalency Agreement**  
**Attestation Statement for Agricultural Products Certified under the USDA  
National Organic Program for Export to Canada**

If you plan to sell a crop for export to Canada under the U.S. – Canadian Equivalence Agreement\*, please note that production of such crops must comply with NOP requirements and the following Canadian restrictions:

- 1. Agricultural products produced with the use of sodium nitrate shall not be sold or marketed as organic in Canada.**
- 2. Agricultural products produced by hydroponic or aeroponic production methods shall not be sold or marketed as organic in Canada.**
