3. What equipment (*owned, borrowed, and custom hired*) comes in contact with both organic and non-organic products? What measures do you take to prevent cross contamination? [NOP §205.201 (a)(5) & §205.272]

Equipment	Procedure to prevent cross contamination

Have documentation of equipment cleaning available for the inspector.

4. What measures do you take to reduce the risk of GMO contamination, especially contamination from GMO pollen? [NOP §205.201 (a)(5) & §205.202 (c)]
5. If you harvest buffer crops, explain how you prevent contamination of organic crops. Explain cleaning of harvest equipment, storage facilities, and how the crop is marketed. [NOP §205.201 (a)(5) & §205.272]
