We are now in the fall season and it is time for the Iowa Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship Horse and Dog Breeding Bureau to send the enclosed **MARE STATUS REPORT(s)**.

We are working in our new software, therefore we are asking for your patience and assistance. Though you may have completed this information in the past, please, aid us by making any corrections on your mare(s) enclosed forms.

**NOTIFICATION OF CHANGE IN BROODMARE STATUS:** Please fill this form out if applicable.

### **MARE STATUS REPORT FORM:**

- A. This form must be completed **PRIOR TO FOALING** for your expected foal to be eligible for the Iowa Breeder's Fund.
  
- B. Your mare must be in the state of Iowa, and this form must be received in our office by **December 31, 2009**, for the mare to meet the instate residency requirements. If not received by December 31, she will need to be bred back to an Iowa standing stallion.
  - 1. This Mare Status form is important. It qualifies your horse for the program. It enables our inspectors to plan their visits to your mare before foaling and after foaling.

2. **Remember: Call your inspector within 72 hours after your foal is born.**
