Sealed bids will be received by the Iowa Department of Agriculture & Land Stewardship, Division of Soil Conservation and Water Quality, 502 East 9th Street, Des Moines, Iowa, 50319, until 3:00 p.m. local time, on the **3rd day of February, 2016** and opened at a public meeting and read aloud on the date last mentioned.

A pre-bid conference will be held on January 22, 2016 at 10:30 a.m., Opera House, 103 Main Street, Bonaparte, Iowa, 52620, telephone: (319) 592-3652. Attendance at the pre-bid conference by prospective bidders is not mandatory, but is encouraged.

In general, the work involves, but is not limited to clearing, grubbing, excavation, terrace construction with tile outlets, concrete pipe, riprap and, permanent seeding, erosion control, and fence construction. The project includes 64,600 cubic yards of excavation, 3,662 lineal feet of terrace construction, 32 linear feet of concrete pipe, 490 tons of riprap, 15.3 acres of seeding, and 400 linear feet of fence. The estimated cost of construction is expected to range from \$225,000 to \$275,000.
