In general, the work involves, but is not limited to: selective clearing; excavation; grading; terrace construction; neutralization of acid water and spoil; erosion and pollution control in accordance with the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP); drainage ditch installation; and dam construction. This project includes 172,682 cubic yards of excavation and 21 acres of subgrade preparation. The estimated construction cost range for this project is \$450,000 to \$500,000.
