

**MCLANDBOROUGH AML RECLAMATION PROJECT
SECTION 8 & 9, T75N, R15W of MAHASKA COUNTY, IOWA

Sealed bids will be received by the Iowa Department of Agriculture & Land Stewardship, Division of Soil Conservation, 502 E 9th Street, Wallace State Office Building, Des Moines, Iowa, 50319, until 2:00 p.m. local time, on the **5th day of February, 2009** and opened at a public meeting and read aloud on the date last mentioned.

In general, the work involves, but is not limited to, selective clearing; excavation; grading; terrace construction; neutralization of acid water and spoil; erosion and pollution control in accordance with the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP); drainage ditch installation; and dam construction. This project includes 279,020 cubic yards of excavation and 58 acres of subgrade preparation. The estimated construction cost range for this project is \$975,000 to \$1,075,000.

The Plans and Construction Specifications governing the construction of the proposed improvements have been prepared by GM Engineering and Surveying, Inc. and are hereby made a part of this notice by reference and the proposed contract shall be executed in compliance therewith.
