## NOTICE-TO-BIDDERS

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**Wilken Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP) Wetland Project  
Section 26, Township 94 North, Range 15 West  
Floyd County, Iowa**

Sealed bids will be received by the Iowa Department of Agriculture & Land Stewardship, Division of Soil Conservation, Henry A. Wallace Building, 502 East 9<sup>th</sup> Street, Conference Room 2, Des Moines, Iowa 50319, until 3:30 p.m. local time, on the 3rd day of July, 2008 and opened at a public meeting and read aloud on the date last mentioned.

In general, the work involves, but is not limited to: selective clearing, excavation, grading, steel sheet pile weir construction, and seeding. This project includes 18,620 cubic yards of earthwork, 928 square feet of sheet pile, 228 tons of riprap, 42 cubic yards of grout, and 20.2 acres of seeding. The estimated construction cost range for this project is \$108,000 to \$118,000.

**A pre-bid conference** will be held at 1:30 p.m., on June 19, 2008, at the Floyd County Soil and Water Conservation District, 623 Beck Street, Charles City, Iowa, 50616, telephone: 641-228-2725. Attendance at the pre-bid conference by prospective bidders is not mandatory, but is encouraged.

Each proposal shall be made on the Proposal and Schedule of Prices form (Document CC) furnished by the Division of Soil Conservation, and must be accompanied by a bid bond, cashier's or certified check drawn on an Iowa Bank or a bank chartered under the laws of the United States. The bid bond shall be in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the base bid (no alternates included), made payable to the Division of Soil Conservation. The bid bond may be cashed by the Treasurer of the State of Iowa, as liquidated damages in the event the successful bidder fails to enter into a contract within fourteen (14) days following Notice-of-Award and post bond satisfactory to the State insuring the faithful performance of the contract. Bid bonds must be executed by corporations authorized to contract as surety in Iowa. Checks of the lowest two (2) or more bidders may be retained for a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days until a contract is awarded or a rejection made. Other checks will be returned after the canvass and tabulation of bids is completed and reported to the Division of Soil Conservation.

Payment to the Contractor for said improvements will be made on the basis of monthly estimates in amounts equal to ninety-five percent (95%) of the work completed. Funding for this project consists of state and federal funds under the Iowa Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program.

The successful bidder shall be required to furnish a Performance/Payment Bond in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price (including accepted alternates). This said bond shall be issued by a responsible surety approved by the State of Iowa; shall guarantee the faithful performance of the contract and the prompt payment of all materials and labor; and shall protect and save harmless the State of Iowa, Natural Resources Conservation Service, and Farm Service Agency from claims and damages of any kind caused by the operations of the Contractor.

The work under the proposed contract shall be commenced within fourteen (14) days after Notice-to-Proceed is received and shall be completed not later than December 15, 2008.

The Plans and Construction Specifications governing the construction of the proposed improvements have been prepared by Monte Applegate and are hereby made a part of this notice by reference and the proposed contract shall be executed in

compliance therewith. Contract Documents (including Plans, Construction Specifications, and Bid Package) may be examined at the following locations:

A successful bidder who is a non-Iowa corporation must submit proof to the Division, prior to the execution of the Contract, of authorization by the Secretary of State to do business in Iowa.
