**WORKSHOP GOAL:** Participants will learn how to integrate watershed management concepts into existing local and regional land use planning initiatives. First-hand Iowa experiences will be shared on how watershed planning was integrated into local and regional planning projects. This type of integrated planning can benefit communities by improving water quality, increasing recreational opportunities, and reducing flood risk.

**WHO SHOULD ATTEND:** Local decision makers with a stake in how agricultural land and environmentally sensitive areas are developed and managed, at a watershed scale, to reduce flood risk and protect water quality.
