



“No Spray” Sign Request

Congratulations on being proactive in protecting your sensitive crops. The Sensitive Crops Directory was created as a resource for pesticide applicators to identify protected crops and apiaries. The “No Spray” sign serves as a visual reminder to those applying pesticides that the designated field has been planted to a sensitive crop and is susceptible to pesticide drift damage.

Signs are available at a cost of **\$10.00 each**.

Signs are 12” x 18” and made of aluminum. Signs are available only to those that have registered. If you need to register your sensitive crops or hives, you may do so by going to the Iowa Department of Agriculture’s Sensitive Crops Directory at http://www.iowaagriculture.gov/Horticulture_and_FarmersMarkets/SensitiveCropDirectory.asp and click on the word “Producers” beneath the yellow airplane.
